



The Draught of a tract of Land situate in Walker Township Centre County Containing two hundred and five Acres, twenty perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c^a Surveyed the 16th day of August 1811, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Henry McCalmont dated the 28th day of March 1811. At the time of making the Survey above described there was a dwelling house on the premises and a family residing therein, who was Tenant to Henry McCalmont who (by information) resided there since the fall of 1810 - by the dwelling House there was about an Acre of land Cleared & fenced - at some distance from the dwelling house on the said tract there was about an acre or an Acre & an half more land Cleared and under fence & grain had been Rept of it last harvest - the last mentioned piece (I am informed) was Cleared in the Year 1797 -
