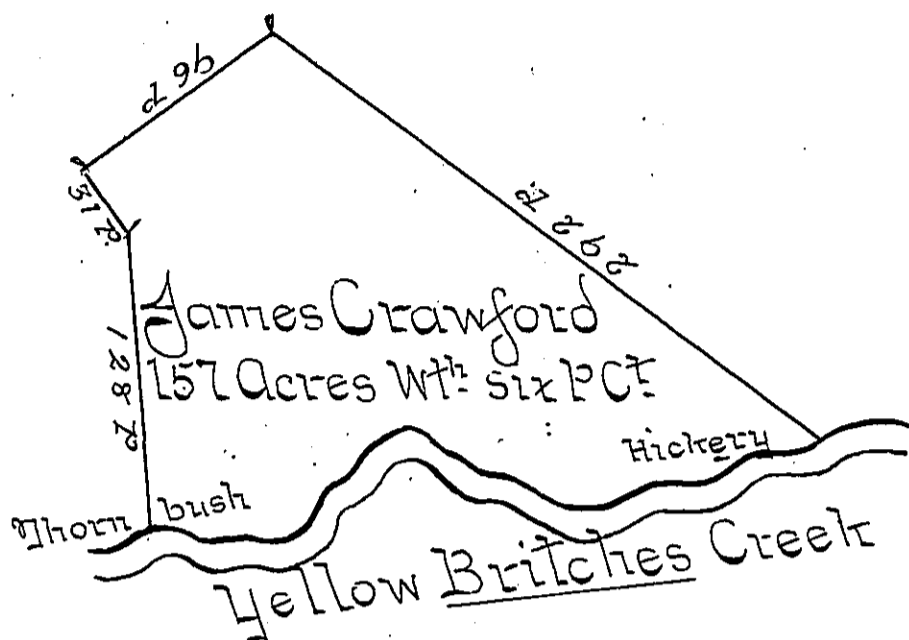

Date the twentieth of October Anno D^o 1738 I have and
Laid out unto James Crawford in the Township of Pens -
borough in the County of Lancaster on the West side of
Susquehanna River One Hundred and fifty seven Acres of
Land with allowance of six P Cent by the Boundaries expressed
in a Table of the Courses and Distances as on the Margin Above
Surveyed May 4th 1743
