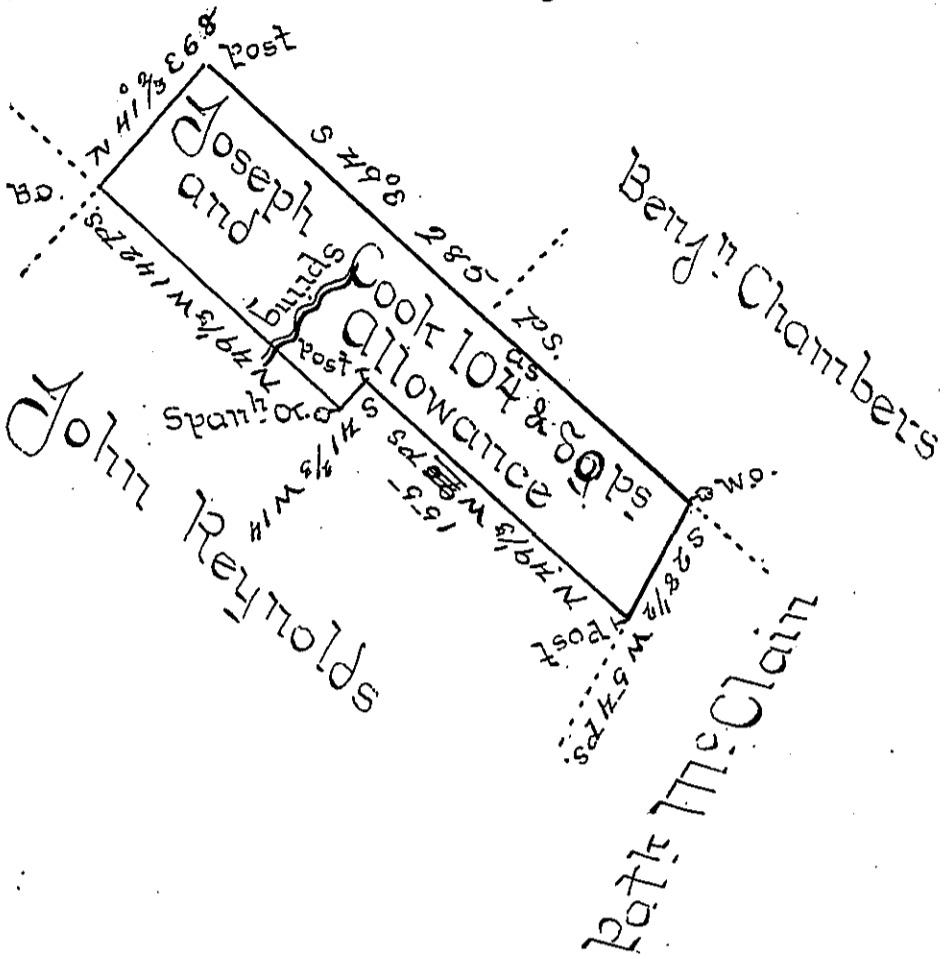


Joseph Cooks other Land
