



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 12<sup>th</sup> December 1792 No. 2378 there was Surveyed the 16<sup>th</sup> August 1794 by Wm P. Brady (the former Deputy Surveyor) to Wilhem Willink Nicholas Staphorst, Christian Van Egham, Hendrick Vollenhover & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck the above described Tract of Nine hundred & five acres and allowance situate on the waters of the little Mahoning in District No. 5 in the late purchase in the County of Lycoming - a copy of which remains in my office.
