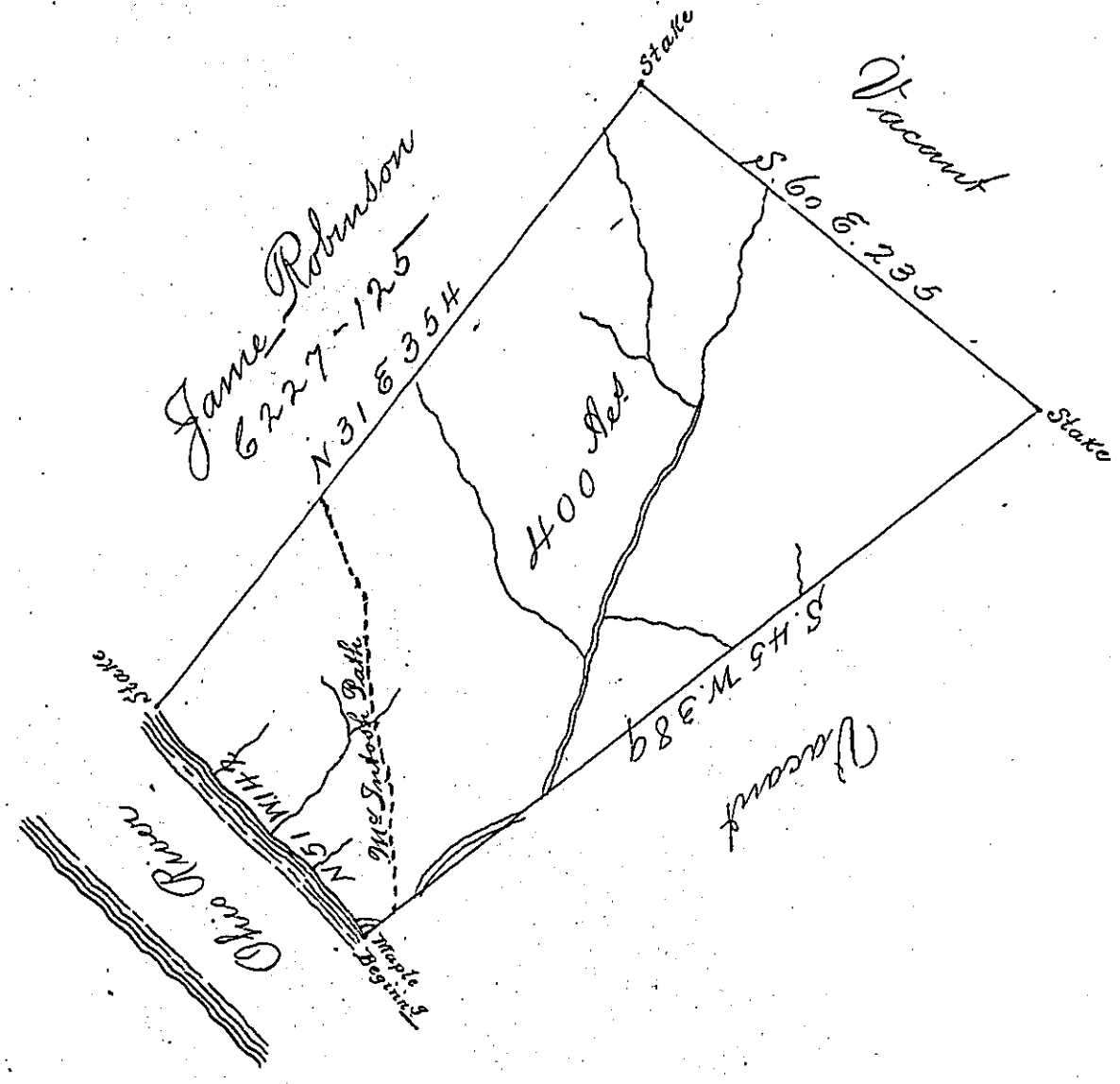

The above is a draught of a Survey made April the 7th 1794 for John Wilkins Ju^r Assignee of Hugh W. Brackenridge and in pursuance of a Warrant Granted Hugh W. Brackenridge for 400 Acs of Land Dated the fourth day of October 1792 Situate three and an half miles from the Ferry Opposite the Town of Pittsburgh on the Alleghany River Lying in the forks of two runs one of them Called the two mile or narrow Run on the Road from Fort Pitt to McIntosh Called Sidney Containing four Hundred acres together with the usual allowance of 6 p^t Cent for Roads
