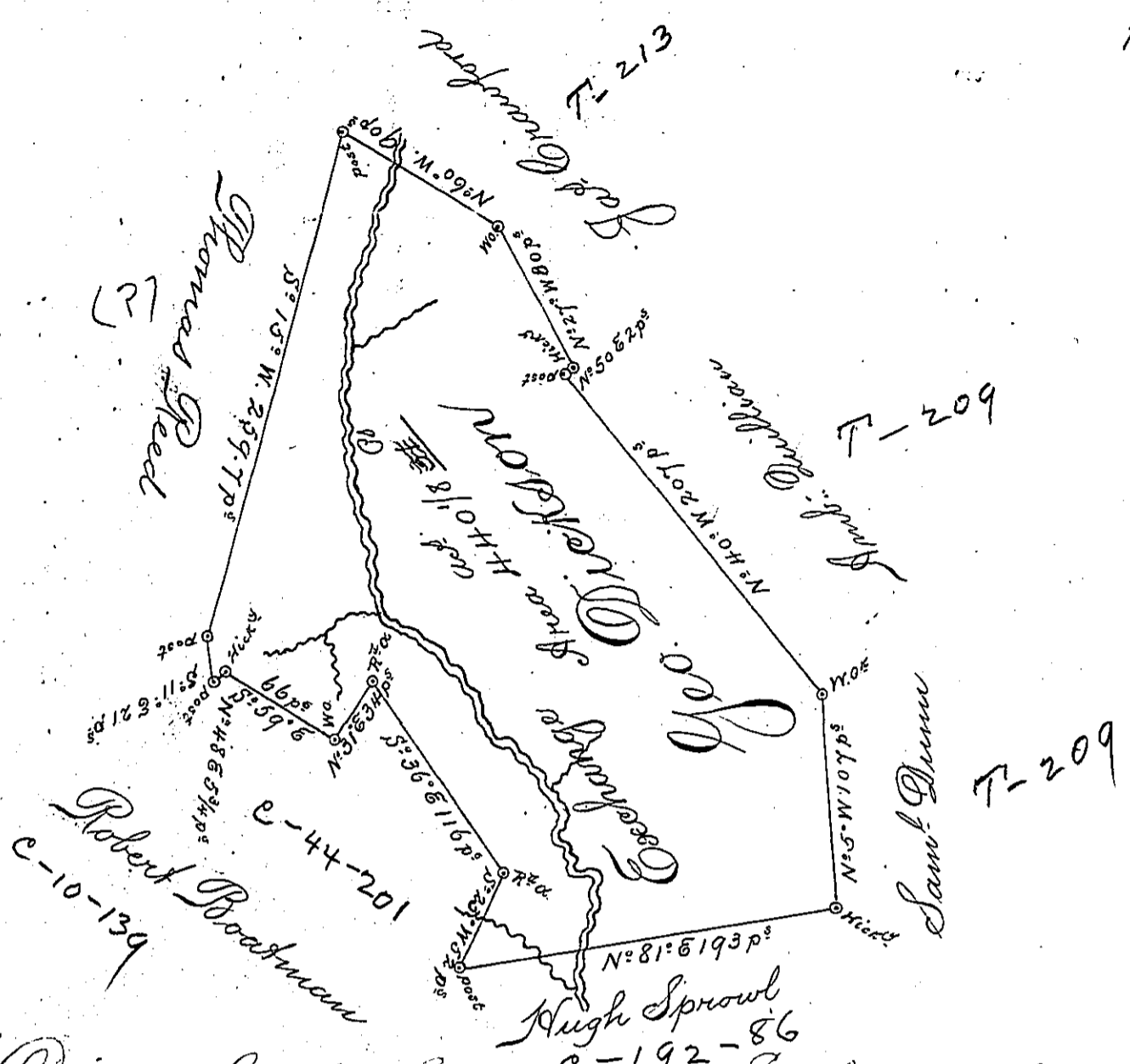

A Draught of a Survey call'd Exchange, lying on Millars Run in Washington County, cont<sup>d</sup> 440 Ac<sup>s</sup> Strict Measure, executed March 10<sup>th</sup> 1786, in Pursuance of a Certificate in the name of Chas<sup>r</sup> Reed for 400 Ac<sup>s</sup> granted him by the Commis<sup>rs</sup> appointed by Virginia to adjust the Titles to unpatented Lands in Y<sup>e</sup> Counties of Monongalia York<sup>a</sup> & Ohio, and entered according to Law with the County Surveyor as appears from the authenticated Transcript of Entries transmitted from the Surveyor Gen<sup>ls</sup> Office
