



Surveyed to James Stewart on the 7th day of November 1817 the above described tract of one hundred and twenty six acres and one hundred and twenty eight perches, and allowance of six per cent adjoining lands of George Grumble Archibald Watson Patrick Lucas Joseph Keen and others including an improvement situate in Armstrong (Westmoreland) now Indiana County By warrant of the 10th day of November A.D. 1800. as appears from papers remaining in my office -
