



By virtue of a Warrant dated the fourth Day of May 1743 - Resurveyed the same Day of August 1745 to Thomas Clarke the above described Tract of Land situate in Falls Township in the County of Bucks Beginning at a post a corner Robert Harveys Land thence by the same S 61° W 93 perches, S 67° W 228 <sup>1/2</sup> perches by S 67° W 244 perches by S 54° W 10 perches thence by S 67° W 112 1/2 perches to the same course by John Harveys Land 6 1/2 perches to a corner of Joseph Kirkbrides Land thence by the same S 65° E 44 per, S 61° E 50 perches, S 57° E 156 perches to a White Oak and S 63° E 268 perches to Delaware River thence down the same 123 perches to the place of Beginning containing three hundred & twenty one acres with allow<sup>t</sup> of six per<sup>ct</sup>.
