



A Draught of a survey situate on the waters of Whiteley Creek called            containing two hundred and fifty acres and <sup>hundred</sup> one and ten perches and allowance of six per cent etc - Resurveyed March the 3<sup>d</sup> 1791 on a warrant granted John Gerard and upon the request dated March 29<sup>th</sup> 1785 and upon the request the said John and John Doanover, who were contending, but who have now settled their dispute, & the above is the draught of survey made agreeably thereto, on which a patent is to issue & not on the former return of John Gerard's survey
