



Draft of a tract of land situated in Salem formerly Hempfield township in the County of Westmoreland containing one hundred and ten acres and forty eight perches, and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c surveyed for Solomon Horn the 28th day of March 1816, by Isaac Hesse D.D. being part of a larger tract of 265 a. and an allowance. Originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to George Clymer dated the 23rd day of August 1776.
