



Situated on both sides of the Great Road leading from Bedford to Fort Pitt between Quenahoning Creek and Caval Hill most part on the north side of said Road adjoining a line Run by William McClay upon the Northwest and including the Big Run in Quenahoning Township Bedford County and surveyed in part 2^d May 1776 unto ^{Alexander McKeown} James McKeown by Warrant dated 26th July 1774 a Return whereof was made into the Office but altered on the 15th Day of February 1787 in order to lay this Warrant and another in the name of James McKeown since come to hand Agreeable to their express Location and as well to include a small Vacancy which had been left out of the former survey & could not be got at without a great deal of trouble as well as making a very irregular figure.
