 been improved since the year 1836. There is also about half an acre of cleared land and a
 dwelling house on the above, the house is situated on the Northern boundary line of the
 survey between the small run and the road, occupied by Ezra Swope, who is a tenant
 of John Flannigan of Philadelphia, said Flannigan claims the part of the above
 survey lying East of the Resurvey line (marked in the above with red ink) by virtue of a
 purchase at Sheriff's sale.
