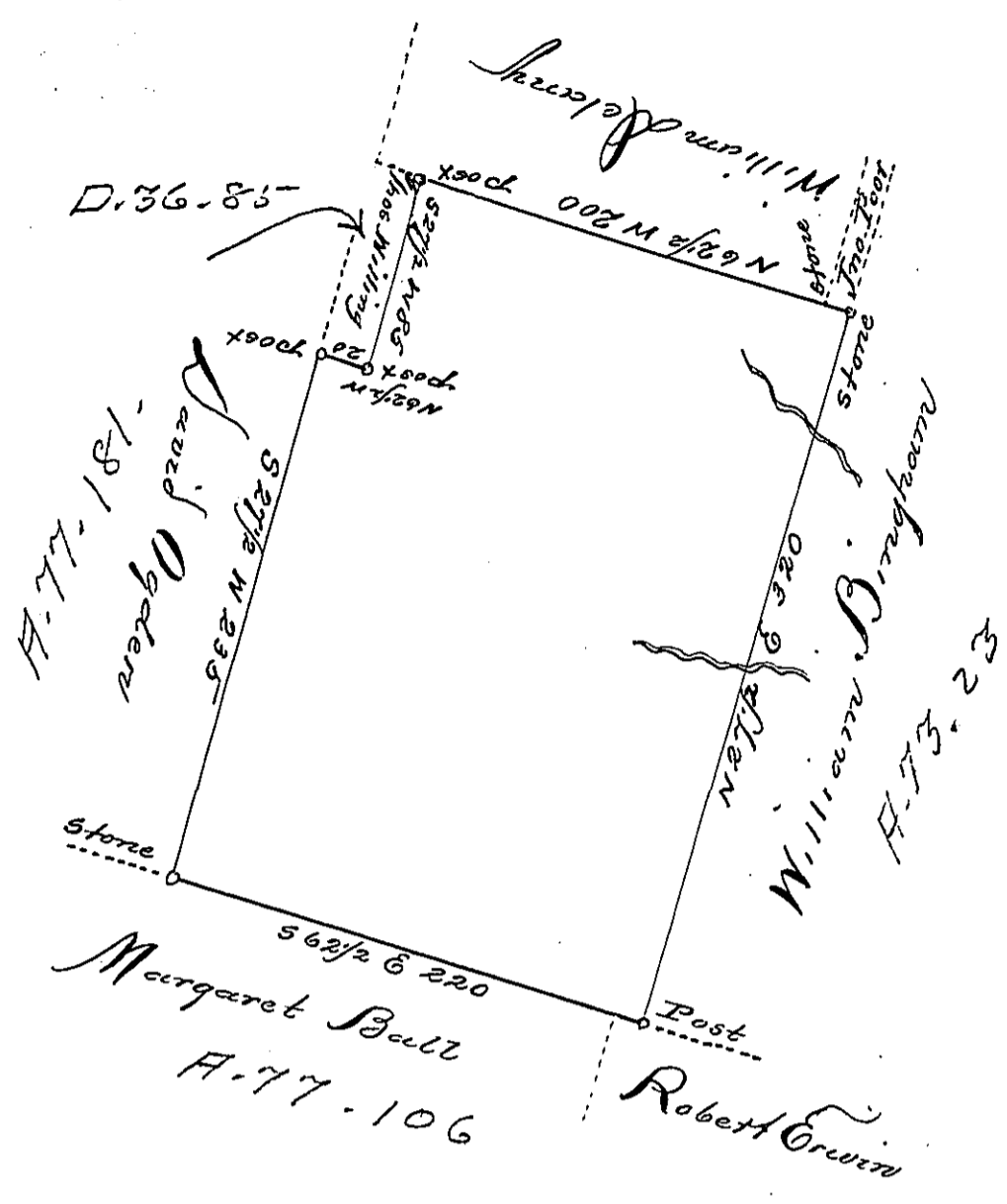

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 13th day of July 1793. and order of Survey recd. the 9th of May 1846. Containing Four hundred and five acres twelve perches and allowance of six m. 6ⁱⁿ for Roads &c.
