



A Draught of survey made 15th October 1819 in pursuance of a warrant granted Jesse Garrison dated Sept. 13th 1819 containing 239<sup>ad</sup> 24ps. and allowance, situated in Franklin Township Greene County on the Waters of the South fork of Ten mile Creek, called Haines' defeat.
