



In pursuance of a warrant for 400 acres dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April 1794 granted to Conrad Dweitzer, was surveyed on the eight day of April 1824. The above described tract of Land, containing 419 acres and 52 perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Situate in Beaver Township Crawford County. Being the same tract which was surveyed to John Ramsey on the 18<sup>th</sup> of October 1794 in pursuance of his improvement bearing date the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October 1794
