



In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and seal of Office from John Lukins Esq<sup>r</sup> Governor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783, the above tract of Land containing two hundred and fifty acres and allowances of 6 yds. only for roads I was surveyed on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785.
