

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12th day of March 1783, for the sale of certain lands herein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and Seal of Office from John Lukens Esquire Surveyor General of the State of Pennsylvania, bearing date the 22nd day of August 1783. The above tract of Land containing three hundred and thirty one acres and 96 perches and a corner of 6 p. long for Roads, was surveyed on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1785, by
