



A Draught of a Tract of Land Called "~~Manitok~~" situated in Buffalo Valley formerly in the County of Berks now Northumberland, containing Three hundred & forty acres 60 perches with the usual allowance of six acres p. Clerk for Roads. Being the allotment which fell to the share of Lieutenant Stewart according to the agreement of the Officers of Col. Francis's Corps. in the Division of a Tract of Eight Thousand acres granted and surveyed for them in Buffalo Valley aforesaid. In pursuance of an order No 1. on the 1st 2^d and 3^d day of March 1769.
