Cent for Roads. Being the allotment which fell to the share of Capt. James Hendricks, according to an agreement made among the Officers of Col. Francis's Corps. In the division of a Tract of Eight Thousand Acres, granted to, and Survey'd for them in Buffaloe Valley aforesaid, on the 1<sup>st</sup>. 2<sup>d</sup> and 3<sup>d</sup> days of March Anno Domini 1769.
