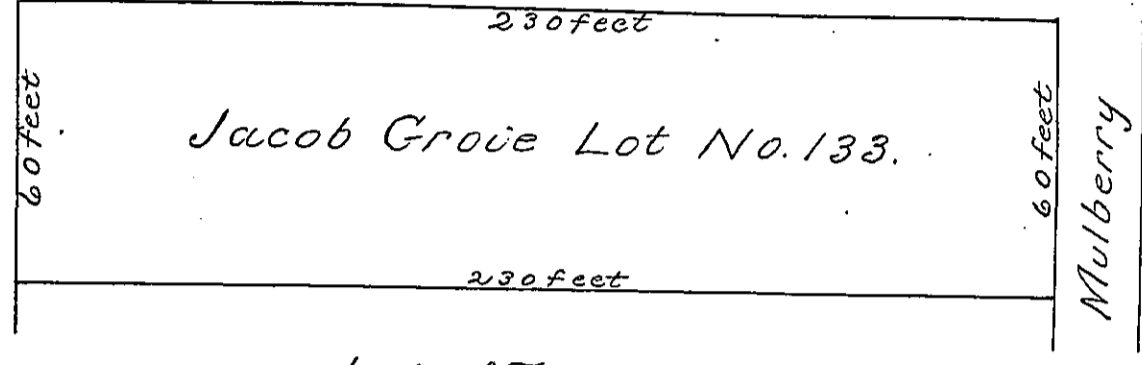

In Pursuance of an Order from the Commission of Property dated the 16th. day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3d. day of July 1772 for Jacob Groie on a certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number one hundred and Thirty three containing in Breadth East and West on Dewberry Street, Sixty feet and in length North & South Two hundred and Thirty feet, Bounded Eastward by Deer Street, Southward by Mulberry Alley, Westward by Lot Number 134, and Northward by Dewberry Street Returned into the Secretary's office the 3d. February <sup>1775</sup> by Vacating Warrant granted the same day to George Toherwood.
