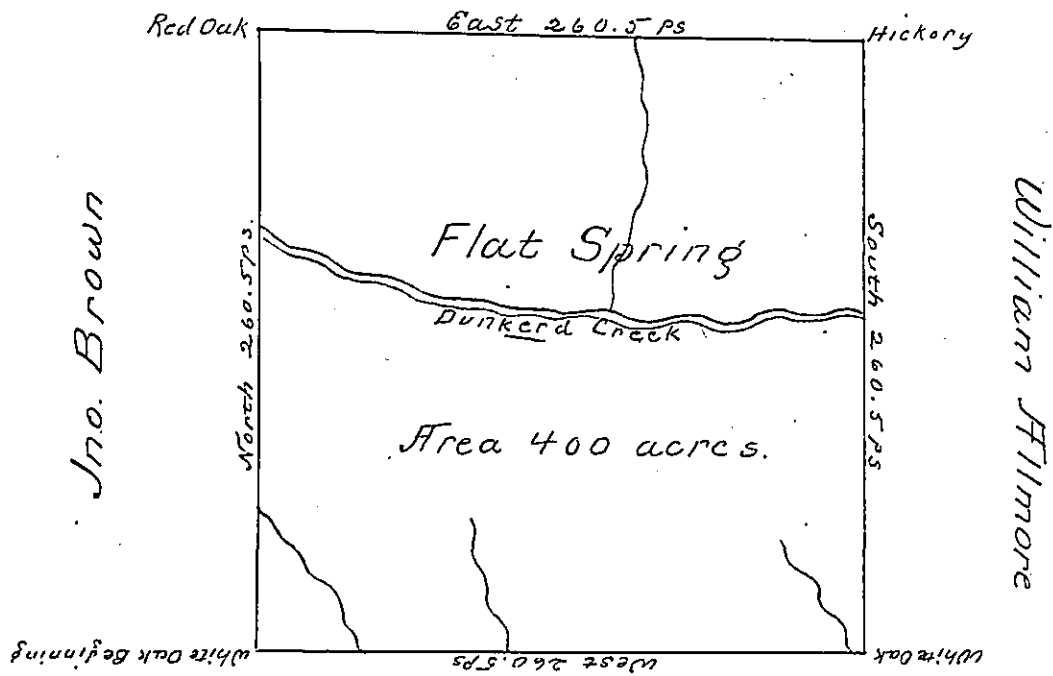


Jacob Deal
