



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor dated the 25th. of 8 mo. Anno. Dom. 1737 the above described land was surveyed unto John Treby Junior in Robinson Township in the County of Lancaster.

Beginning at a white oak a corner of the land of James Swasser thence south by vacant land 156 perches to a white oak Thence north 80 degrees west by the land of Alexander Brindley 110 perches to a Small white oak thence north by Vacant Land 156 perches to a post Thence South 80 degrees east by Vacant Land & ye Land of James Swasser 110 perches to ye place of Beginning containing one hundred acres beside ye allowance of Six o for Roads.
