

With the Commissioners appointed to adjust the claims to unpatented Lands in the
Counties of Monongahala & Ohio do hereby certify that William
Ridder is entitled to four hundred acres of Land in the County of Ohio in
Peterson Creek to include his Settlement in the year of 1774 also a Right in Pre-emption
to one Thousand acres adjoining thereto - Given under our hands at Gops fort the
24th February 1780 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
