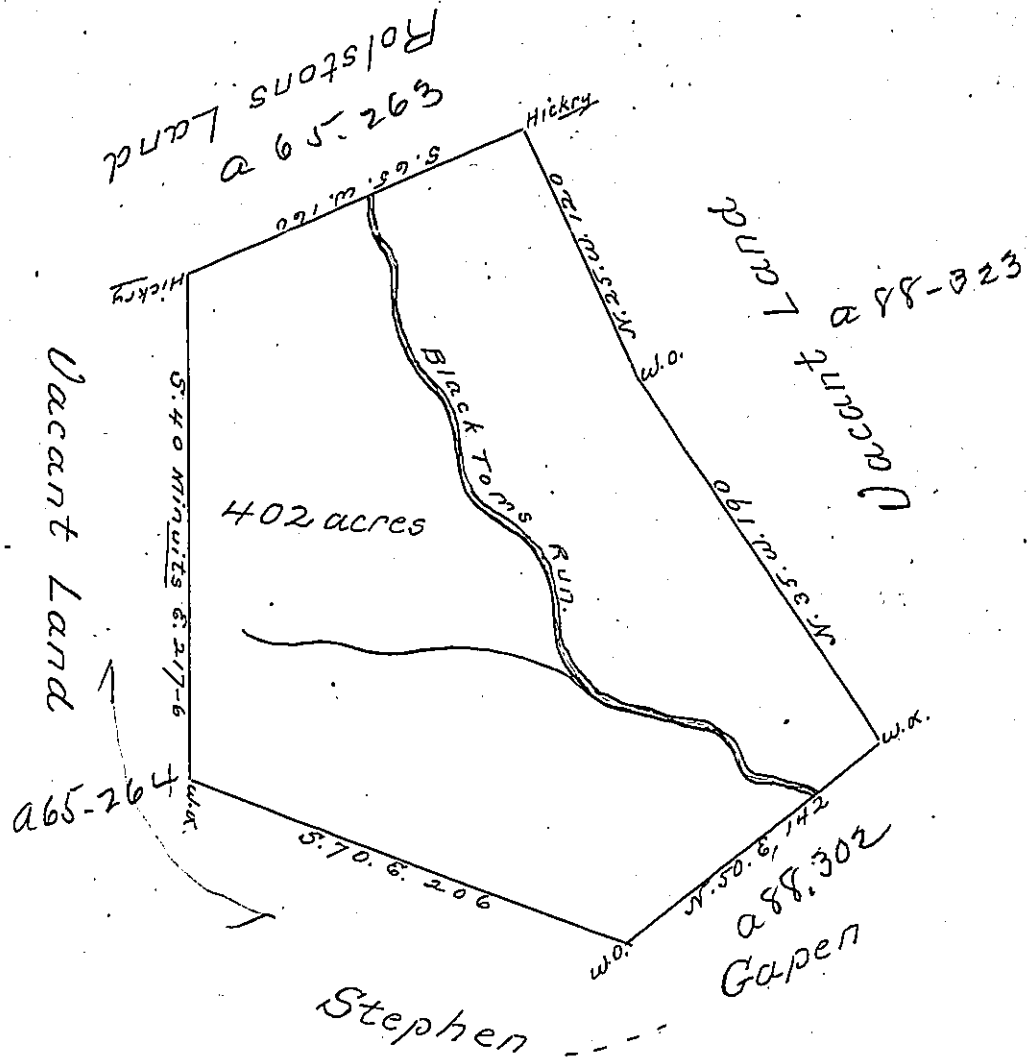

A Draught of a Survey Situate above the waters of Dunkard Creek called Walnut Slick in Washington County & Green Township Surveyed November 4th Day 1790 containing four hundred and two acres and allowance of Six per Cent &c. In pursuance of a Warrant granted Benjamin Wynkoop the twenty third day of December 1784.

Note - the aforesaid warrant was originally executed on another tract of land and the return thereof made to the S. G. office, but was afterwards found to interfere with prior surveys, I therefore (on the request of the owner) made & returned the above Survey.
