E. 117 perches to a post, thence by ^{Edward the same} Farmers Land N 50 E 177 perches to a post in a line of Upper Dublin Township thence by the same S. E. 123 perches to a post, thence by Cheltenham Township S. W. 189 perches to the place of Beginning, Containing 158 acres
