



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Third day of August 1734
 Surveyed unto William Thomas a tract of Land situate in Milton in the County
 of Bucks. Beginning at a post at corner of John Kellys Land thence by the
 same south east one hundred and twenty eight perches to a corner stone, thence by land
 of Evan Thomas south west sixty nine perches and by Vacant land the same course ninety
 six perches to a post in a line of Thomas Edwards land, thence by the same north
 west seventy perches & by Vacant land the same course fifty eight perches to a
 post, thence by land of John Vaccines & Edward Jones north east one hundred and sixty
 five perches to the place of Beginning. Containing One hundred and twenty five
 acres with the usual Allowance of six p. Cent.
