



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries date the fifteenth day of June 1734, surveyed unto Thomas Thomas a tract of land situate <sup>172</sup> Hilton Township in the County of Bucks, Beginning at a Hickery a corner of William Thomas's land thence by the same North East one hundred and thirty four perches to a Hickery another corner of <sup>S</sup> Wm Thomas's Land thence by the same South East one hundred perches to a White Oak thence by Land of William Lewis South West one hundred and thirty four perches to a post, thence by Land late of James Lewis dec'd North West twenty perches and by Land of <sup>S</sup> Wm Thomas the same course eighty perches to <sup>2</sup> place of beginning, Containing seventy nine acres with the usual allowance of six per Cent
