



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries date the fifteenth day of June 1734, surveyed unto Thomas Thomas a tract of land situated ⁱⁿ Hell-ton Township in the County of Bucks, Beginning at a Hickery a corner of William Thomas's land thence by the same North East one hundred and thirty four perches to a Hickery another corner of S^r Wm Thomas's land thence by the same South East one hundred perches to a White Oak thence by Land of Wilson Lewis South West one hundred and thirty four perches to a post thence by Land late of James Lewis deceased North West twenty perches and by Land of Wm. Thomas the same course eighty perches to $\frac{1}{2}$ place of beginning. Containing seventy nine acres with the usual allowance of six feet front.
