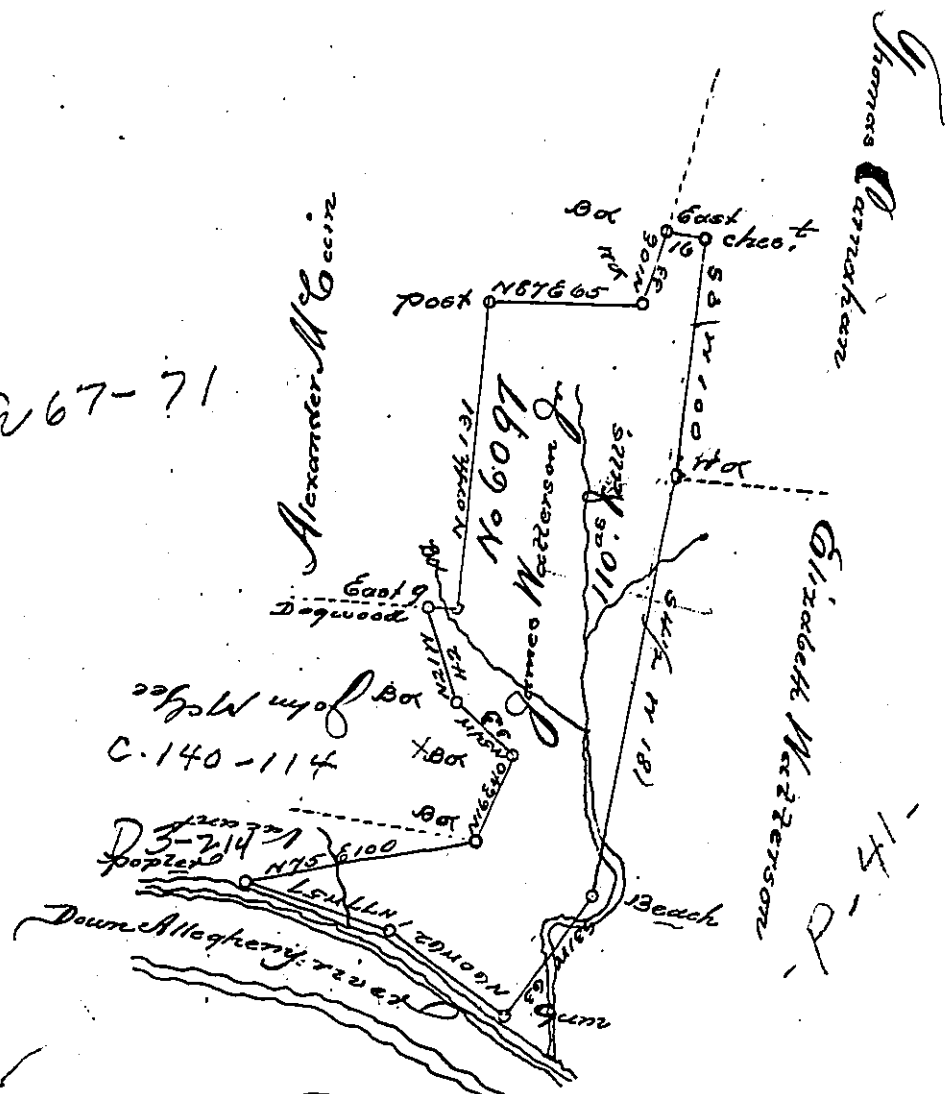

Yee, Alexander McCaig and others, Toby Township Armstrong County. And also do certify that said Watterson is actually residing on the above mentioned Tract and is engaged in improving the same.
