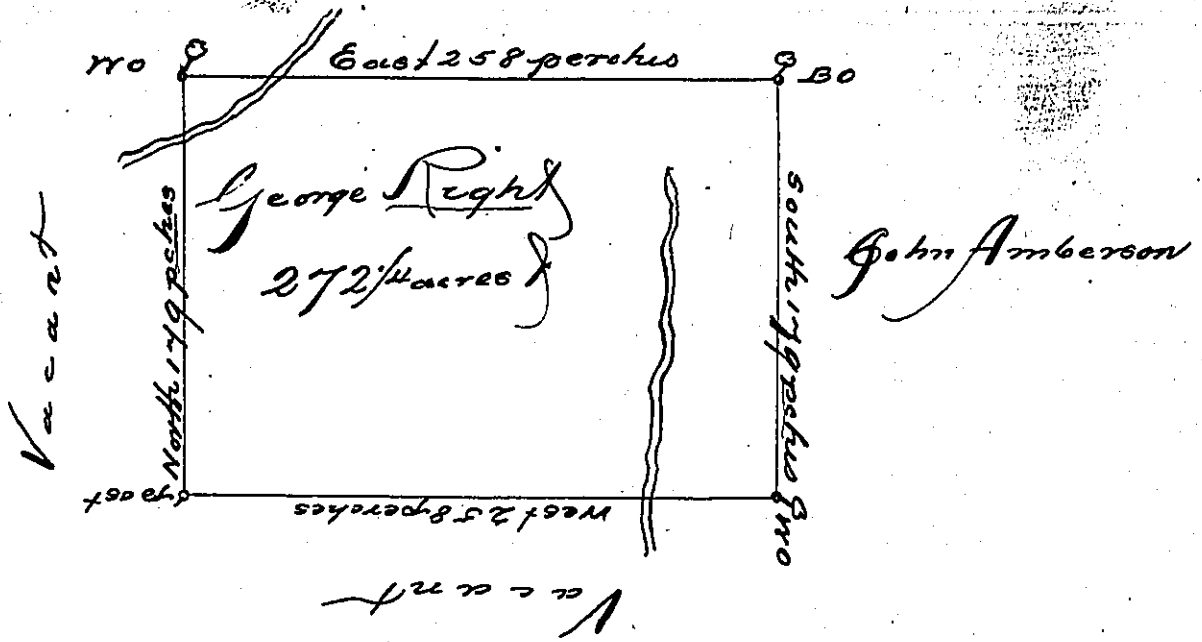


Proprietaries Manor
