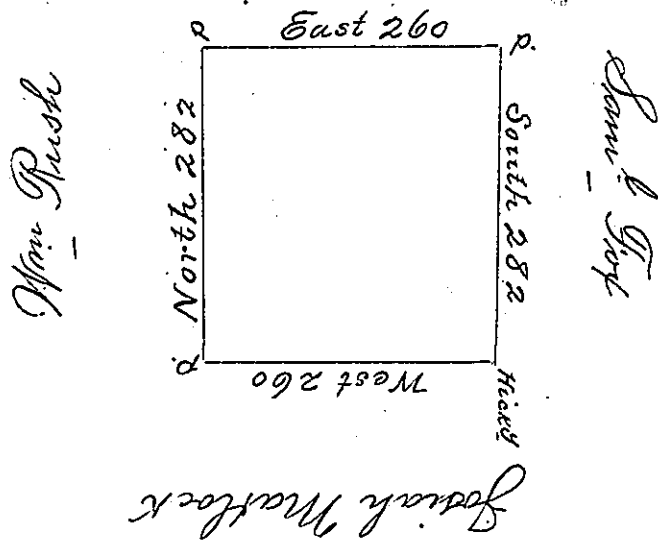

The above is the draught of a survey made May 12th 1794 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Robert Waln on the 25th day of April 1793 situate Northwest of the Ohio river on the waters of Beaver Creek adjoining lands granted to William Potter called Languedoc containing 432 acres & 48 perches with the usual allowance of 6 p^{ct} Cent &c^a
