Dom. 1737 Was Surveyed unto Evan Thomas The above Described Tract of Land in Robinson Township in the County of Lancaster Beginning at a Black Oak a Corner of the Land of William John Adams Thence North 30 Degrees West by the same and Vacant Land 240 perches to a Black Oak Thence South 6.5 Degrees West by Vacant Land 290 perches to a White Oak Thence South 42 Degrees East by Vacant Land 370 perches to a Post Thence North 5.5 Degrees East by Vacant Land 149 perches to a Post Thence North North West by the Land of William John Adams 67 perches to a White Oak Thence North 40 Degrees East by y<sup>e</sup> same Land 58 perches to y<sup>e</sup> place of Beginning Containing Four Hundred Seventy Five Acres beside the allowance of Six p Cent For Roads
