



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Bearing Date the Ninth Day of August Anno Dom 1737 Surveyed to James Galbreath A Tract of Land joining on Spring Creek & Swataroc Creek In the Township of Derry Lancaster County Beginning at a Hickory tree by the North East side of Spring Creek being a corner of Sarah Grahams Land thence by s.d. Land North 40 Deg West 156 p to a Black Oak by the side of Swataroc Creek then Down by the s.d. Creek thirty two perches to a Hickory standing by the Lower side of Spring Creek (mouth) then up by the N.E. side of s.d. Spring Creek Ninety Eight perches to a Black oak then over the s.d. Creek by a Mill about six perches then up the N.W. side of s.d. Creek 141 p to the Beginning Containing fifty three acres and the usual allow of six p<sup>ts</sup> Surveyed April 4<sup>th</sup> 1738 By S<sup>r</sup> Blunstone
