Pursuant to the Proprietary Warrant Dated y^e 9 day of December Anno Dom. 1736 and at y^e Request of the Surveyor General I surveyed a Tract of Land in The Dyffryn in Chester County for Abel Griffith Beginning at a corner of Thomas German's Land and the same that Thomas James owns for a corner of his Land Purchased of Col. Evans Attorney (Called Mordant's Tract) thence East North East 206 Perches into the line of George Hughs Land thence by the same North North West 78 Perches to a corner Nickerly thence West South West 206 Perches to a corner Black Oak then South South East 78 Perches to the first mentioned corner, Containing One Hundred acres & 68 Perches. Survey y^e 7th Day of y^e 1st mo. called March 1738/9

Note. by an E. N. E course from y^e first mentioned corner (which is y^e course of German's head line & y^e reputed course of ~~the~~ Ally^e Head lines of y^m Tracts) we fell into S^r Geo.
