



Pursuant to an Order to me directed bearing Date the 25th of January 1748 Surveyed for the use of the Honorable Proprietaries the following Tract of land situate in the Forks of Neshaminy in the Towns^h of Warwick in the County of Bucks Beginning at a stone corner of Joseph Roberts's land & thence extending by the same the lands of John Roberts, Robert Walker & Jnr. McCulloch North East 51 1/2 per^s to a white Oak, thence by the lands of Dr. John Rodman North West 61 Per^s to an heap of Stone near the N. West side of Neshaminy Creek, thence by the same the lands of Robert Stuart & John Ewers, ^{545⁵⁵W^{ft}} 51 1/2 Per^s to a post thence by the lands of Mrs. McDaniel & Richard Thomas South East 69 Per^s to the place of Beginning Containing 196^a 58 Per^s with allowance @ 6 p Cent &c^a Surveyed 10^{br} 2^d 1749
