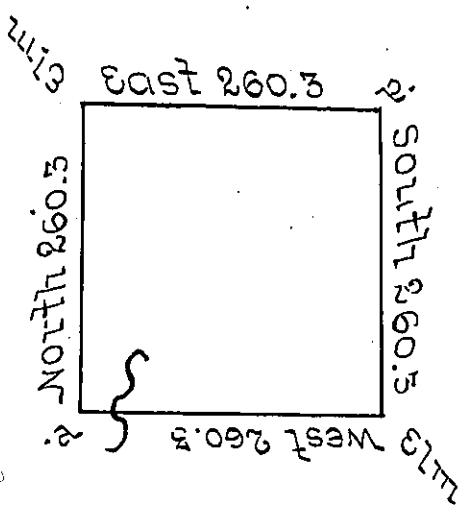


Donation Land

The above described tract of land situate in my District Beaver County adjoining land granted to John Dorsey called Wyonnois containing 400 Acres with the usual allowance was surveyed by John Redick & myself under the direction of John Hoge Esq^r late Deputy Surveyor in the month of March 1705. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Richard Wells dated on the 25th day April 1703. which survey was returned into the Surveyor Gen^l office by said Hoge as if surveyed in May 1704. the last mentioned date of survey being erroneous I do now Certify, and return this survey into the Surveyor Gen^l Office for the purpose of correcting said error, in compliance with the order of the Board of Property dated the 8th day of June 1803
