



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Upper Milford Township in the County of Northampton in the State of Pennsylvania Containing Twenty Two Acres 57 Perches of Land Together with the usual Allowance of Six per cent for Roads -- That was Surveyed by Edward Scull on the 14th August 1752 for Michael Rishel -- Long afterwards the heirs of the said Michael Rishel deceased Sold and Conveyed Their Right to the above Tract as well as to all their other Land to George Shlywer who again in the year 1773 Sold and Conveyed The same to the Revd Jacob Van Buskirk Now drawn for the said Jacob Van Buskirk By Order of The Surveyor General on the 18th January Anno 1788.
