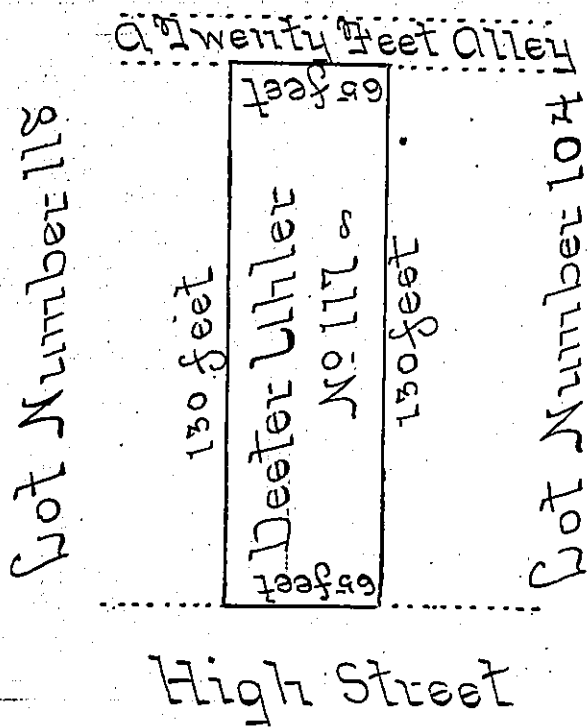


Rent to commence from

A Plan of a Lot of Ground situate on the North side of High Street in the Town of York marked on the General Plan of the said Town Number one hundred and seventeen containing in Breadth on High Street aforesaid sixty five Feet and in length to a Twenty feet Alley two hundred and thirty Feet bounded southward with High Street aforesaid Westward with a Lot of Ground marked in the Plan aforesaid Number one hundred and eighteen, Northward with a Twenty Feet Alley and Eastward with a Lot marked on the Plan aforesaid Number one hundred and four surveyed for Deeter Uhler who has built an House thereon agreeable to the Conditions of settling the Town
