



The above described tract of land is situate in Centre Township Indiana County containing Ninety acres and one hundred and thirty three perches and Allowance it being part of a larger tract of 132 acres and Allowance originally Surveyed the 27<sup>th</sup> of September 1788 to Robert Hazlet in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 23<sup>d</sup> day of April 1787 - Resurveyed to John Coleman ~~the~~ ~~the~~ on the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 1815 excluding therefrom that part of the old survey of said Robert Hazlet which is included in a survey made to William Evans on Warrant dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1802 (as represented by the dotted lines and the letters A. B. & C. on the above diagram) By order of the Board of property dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> of May 1815 - Copied from Minute Book No 5. page 248.
