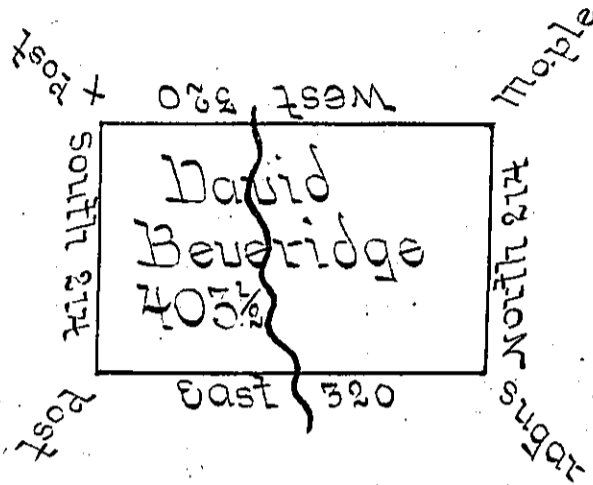


Alex<sup>e</sup> Cochran
