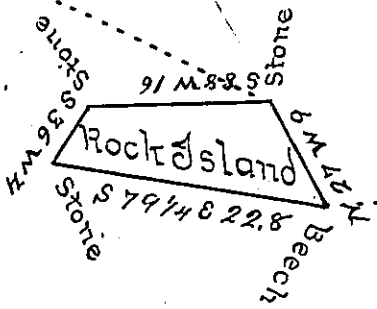
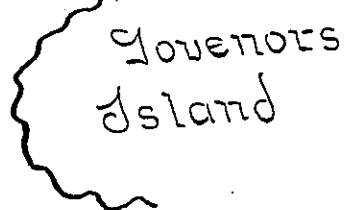

 opposite the upper part of Samuel Rogers Land on the Lancas-

 Governors Island and about a half a Mile below Heirs  
 Island Containing one hundred and five perches of Land  
 Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated the Nineteenth  
 day of May 1806 granted to Isaac Walton surd 11 June 1806 by
