



Pursuant to an order of the Board of Property to us directed Bearing date the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March 1795 we the subscribers on the 31<sup>st</sup> Day of August 1796 have proceeded to Survey the above described Island situate in the River Susquehanna near Mr. Kee's Riffels about fifty perches from the West side of the River in Mahanoy Township & County of Northumberland, and finds the same to contain two Acres & Allowance about an Acre of which hath been Cultivated and we do value the same at at three Pounds per Acre.
