 issioppin in the County of Philad<sup>a</sup> Beginning at a corner  
 post of Gabriel Shoolers Land thence by Vacant Land  
 North West one hundred & sixty Perches to a post thence  
 by Vacant Land North East two hundred & Twelve perches  
 to a Hickery Tree Standing on the West bank of Perkiomie  
 Creek thence by Vacant Land South East one Hundred  
 & Sixty perches to a Cherry tree in the line of Gabriel  
 Shoolers land thence by ye Same South West two hundred
