Parker's Land at a corner of the Land of John Taylor thence W. by N. by ye said Parker's Land 106 p's to a small Hickery thence S. by E. by ye Land of James Gibbon 34 pches to a post thence S. by E. along ye Barren 106 p's to a post thence N. by W. by the sd John Taylor's Land 346 p's to ye Place of Beginning Containing two Hundred acres and the Allowance of six P Cent^s Thomas Green has sold this Tract to David Sheter --- John Taylor
