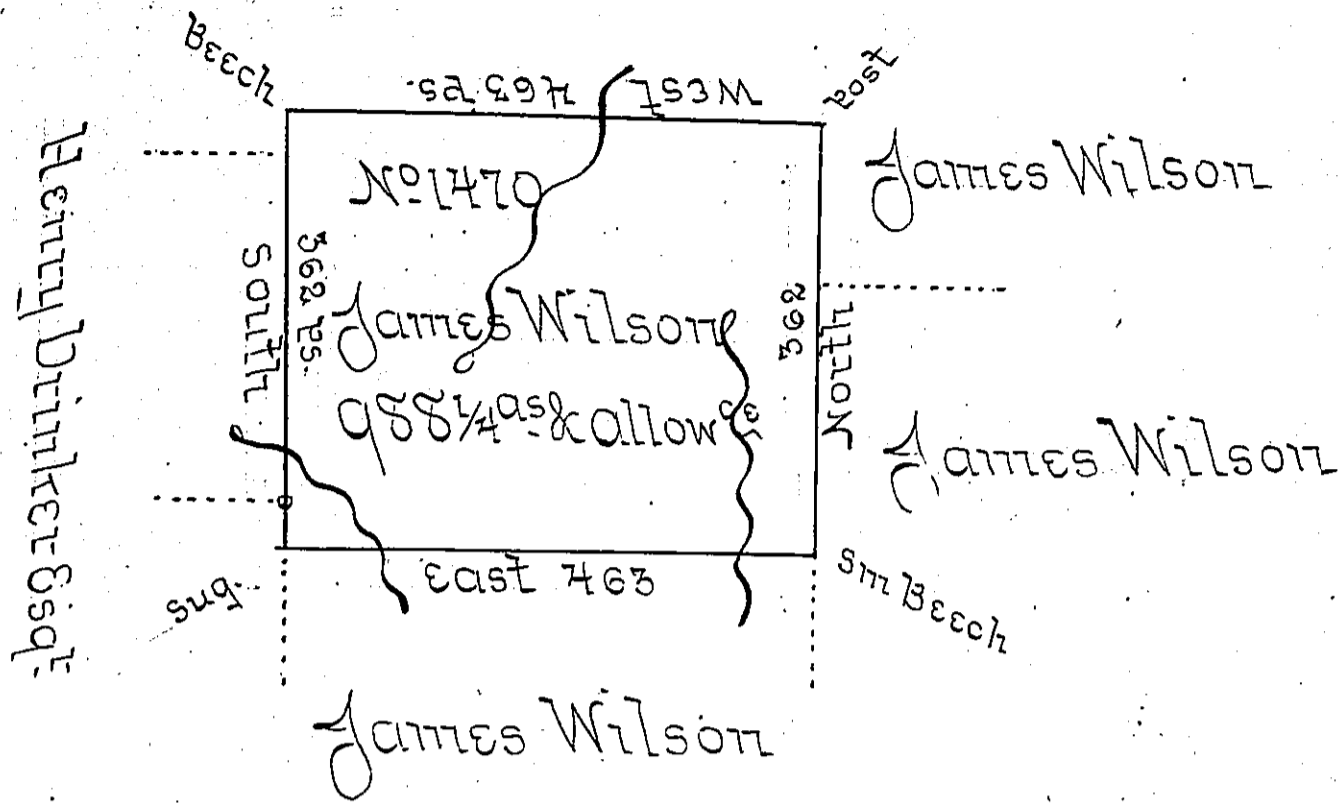


James Wilson
