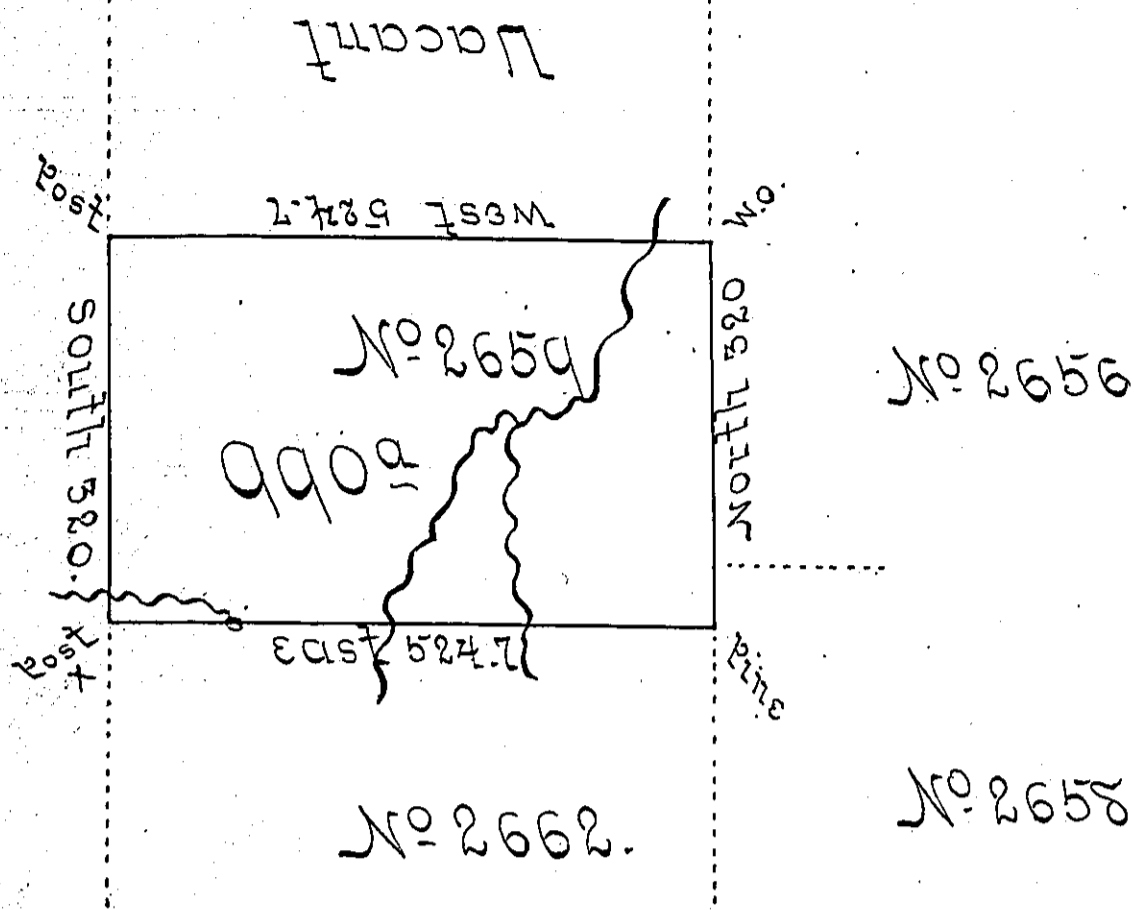


Jno Brodhead's District
