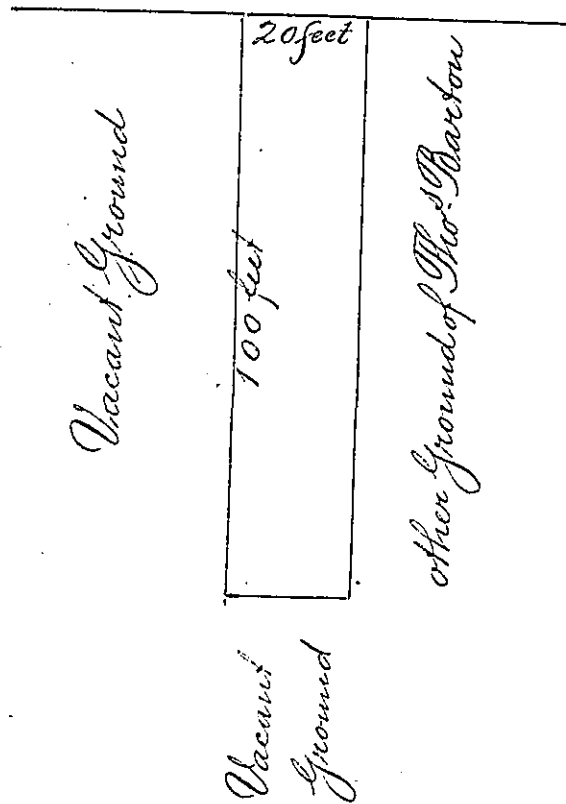


Callorhill Street
