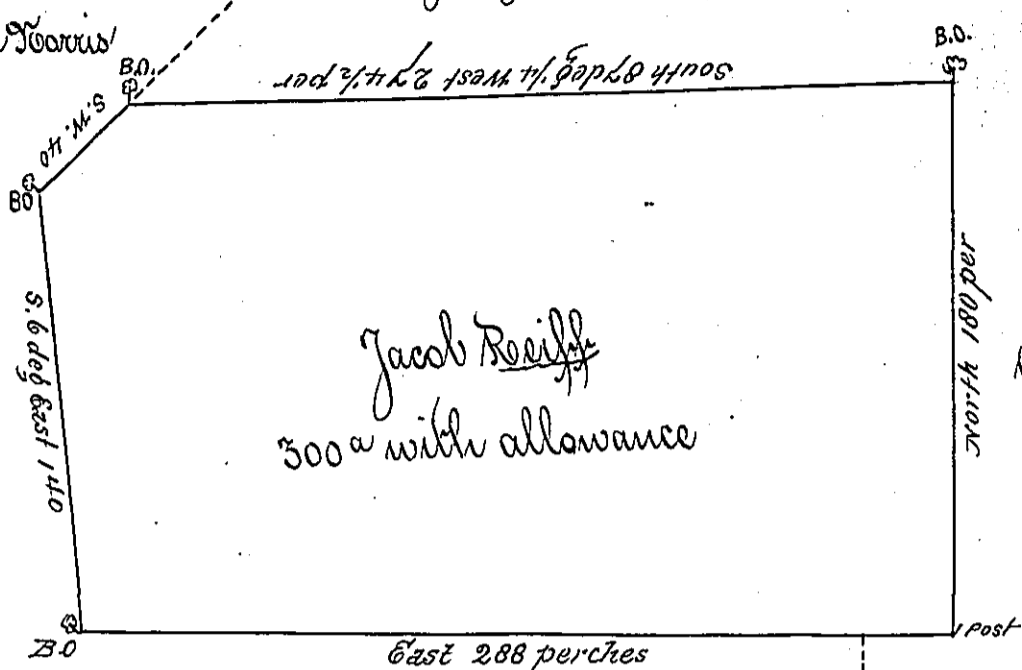

By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietors bearing date the 4th Day of September Anno Dom 1734 surveyed on the 7th Day of April Anno Dom 1736 to Jacob Reiff a tract of Land in the Township of Hempf^d & County of Lancaster Beginning at a Black Oak a Corner of Herman Longs Land thence East 288 perches to a post thence North 180 per to a Black Oak thence South 87 deg 1/4 West 274 per 1/2 to a Black Oak thence South West 40 per to a Black Oak thence South 6 deg East 140 per to the place of Beginning Containing three Hundred Acres with the usual allowance of six acres per Cent for Roads &c
