



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries bearing date the 9th Day of August 1757 Surveyed to William Bertram in the Township of Hanover in Lancaster County a tract of Land joining on the north side of Duataro Creek Beginning at a Black Birch by the S. Creek thence North 85 deg. West 158 perches to a Black Oak thence South 25 deg. West 218 perches to a Dogwood thence South 66 deg. West 41 perches to a Licory on Duataro Creek thence up the several Courses of the said Creek 201 perches to the place of Beginning containing three hundred seventy two acres with the usual allowance of 6. % for Roads &c Surveyed April the 12th 1758
