



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 30th Day of the second month April Anno Domini 1736 - The above Described Tract of Land was surveyed unto Francis Jones in the Township of Salisbury - in Lancaster County Beginning at a Black, at a Corner of another Tract of the said Francis Jones thence North by John Hitchell 21 perches to a Black Oak thence East North East by Vacant Land and Land lately surveyed to the said Francis - 140 perches to a Post thence South 20 Degrees ^{East} by Thomas Bankover 28 perches to a White Oak thence North 70 Degrees East by the same 96 perches to a White Oak thence South 20 Degrees East by the same 86 perches to a Black Oak thence West by Samuel Garretts and y^e first mentioned Tract of Francis Jones 258 perches to the place of Beginning containing Eighty ~~two~~ acres beside the Allowance of six p^{er}cent.
